SABRINA BRIDGE CHAOS

Recent roadworks have been causing chaos for residents and students in St Clement. The decision to close Sabrina Bridge for repairs at the same time as commencing roadworks in St John's has further exacerbated the disruption.

Tor Pingree said, "the problem of congestion in St John's is not going to be resolved by work designed to get cars travelling through the area more quickly because it will simply attract more cars. The County Council is once again prioritising traffic over residents.

Tor also expressed astonishment at the timing of the Sabrina Bridge closure, which coincided with the start of term for university students. "Clearly it is important to keep this vital bridge in a good state of repair but there seems to have been minimal consultation over the start date for this work. Most university students do not drive, so to close the bridge just as they are arriving in Worcester not only creates a huge inconvenience but also sends a really poor message".
